## ***Guidance Note To Be Issued To Members Of The Congregation At The Wesley Hall Site Of Wesley Ebenezer Methodist Church***

### **Background to the Note**

It is very exciting that as a church we benefit from Matt's work as our Building Manager and Liz's work as our Children and Families Worker. Following their employment, it seems that the time is right to provide the congregation with details of the structure that the Church Council has seen fit to put in place, to support both Matt and Liz in their work.

Both Matt and Liz are employed directly by the Church Council. The Church Council has delegated the role of management and supervision of its employees to their respective Management Teams. Both Liz and Matt therefore have separate Management Teams, the membership of which will be reviewed annually by the Church Council.

### **Role of Management Team**

The Management Team's responsibility is to:

- Become familiar with the work of the employee
- Determine priorities for the work with the employee
- Monitor and evaluate progress with the employee on a regular basis
- Act as a 'sounding board' for the employee
- Negotiate with the employee appropriate levels of pastoral support outside management structures (where applicable)
