Summer Fun Days, Friday 26th July and Thursday 1st August, 10am-4pm



The daughter of friends of ours in Germany is going to be spending the Autumn term at Silverdale School, and we are desperately looking for a host family for her to stay with: the school has firmly (and rudely!) refused to offer any help in finding her somewhere to stay because of "child protection issues" (we had naively expected they would at least announce it in the language classes to see if any parents would be interested...), so we're asking around all our friends/colleagues etc. in the hope that somebody will know a suitable family. She would be a paying guest, and would like to be in a family with children (ideally with some about the same age as her, and/or attending Silverdale).
