

Brief Description

Wesley Hall are looking for a Building Manager to organise ongoing works required to the building, maximise income from lettings, increase community use and apply for grant assistance towards the maintenance and running of the building.

Funding has been secured for one year after which the employment is dependent upon continued funding from grants and/or other sources.

Main Duties

- To develop the property in order to better serve the neighbourhood and to promote social action and community engagement.
- To build on and develop partnerships with both secular and ecumenical partners.
- To source funding from grant making bodies in order to support existing mission; identify and initiate new projects which will benefit the community and ensure the post is self-sustaining.
- To enable the continued proper use of resources by looking after room bookings, keeping the booking diary up to date, dealing with requests from those hiring rooms and ensuring all used space is invoiced.
- To engage and manage architects and contractors to keep the building in a good state of repair.
- To ensure compliance with all relevant legislation applicable to a public building.
- To keep the Church accounts and associated duties.
- To provide a quarterly summary of church finances and report to the Church Council.
- To prepare a budget and enable the Church to have a sound financial policy.

Closing date for applications is Friday 1st April 2011.

Interviews will be held during the week commencing Monday 4th April 2011.
