#### ❖ "Finding Dory"




#### WEADS Panto February 2017

#### Taizé Retreat in Sheffield

This article, written by Mark Ansell, was published in the newsletter of Taizé last month. It was translated into over 30 languages and also used on various social media in the UK as well at churches in Sheffield. It's about the Taizé weekend held here at Wesley Hall in October.

"Thirty young adults from across the country came to Sheffield to take part in a Taizé retreat weekend. Many of the people who'd travelled to Wesley Hall in Crookes - which is where we based ourselves - were Europeans living and working in Britain. We had a Pole, a Hungarian, a German and two Dutchmen. This brought a really special dynamic to the weekend of people from different backgrounds coming together to socialise, pray, sing and share silence and meals together.

Most of the participants slept at the Methodist church in Crookes and we all ate our meals there together – taking it in turns in the kitchen. Just like at the Taizé community in France, we held three prayer services a day. After the Saturday morning prayer we spent time in silence with many heading to Bole Hills to take time-out and reflect.

We were fortunate enough to have the use of Sheffield Cathedral and the highlight for many was the Saturday evening workshops and prayer service there. One of the workshops was led by Adnan Khalid who is a Muslim from Leeds and an expert on Islam. He told us of the many links between Christianity and Islam and that the word Islam means peace. This was followed by another enjoyable communal meal and then a beautiful Taizé prayer in the Cathedral which was attended by a hundred people.

Although the retreat had officially finished after a lunch together on Sunday afternoon, the monthly Taizé prayer at St Mark's as part of Night Service happened to be on that day. This meant that many of us got together one last time to sing the chants of Taizé, pray and spend time together in God's presence.

A Taizé prayer takes place on the third Sunday of every month at 8pm in St Mark's Church, Broomhill, as part of the Night Service. You'd be very welcome to join us. To keep up to date search 'Taizé in Sheffield' on Facebook and request to join the group. Mark Ansell."
