Firstly, thank you to everyone who has completed the Safeguarding Training – we have trained over 100 people so far. However, there is still a little way to go. We have set up another five sessions, which has been very difficult to fit in given the other work that is going on, but given the vital importance of this training some things have had to give in order for people to have the opportunity to attend a session.

Nearly everyone who has attended the session has felt that the time has been well spent. At the heart of our faith is the love and care of our neighbour. This training does just that, as it is equipping us to understand more about what abuse is and how to look around at others and look for any signs of abuse that they may be suffering, and be able to play our part in helping them. It is NOT about accusing us / you of abuse, or saying that we / you cannot be trusted – it is quite the opposite.
