❖ **Christian Aid Week (15-21 May)**

In 2015, £73,230 was raised across Sheffield as part of Christian Aid Week, being one of the most successful areas in the country for fundraising. Many thanks to all who contributed to our own efforts last year, when an amazing £1,709 was raised (probably the most while Andrea Killingsworth has been co-ordinating the week's activities). This year their focus will be on climate change, especially working with local partners helping Bangladeshi communities badly affected by flooding (caused by climate change), and also tax injustice which defrauds the poor of huge amounts of money which could fund basic infrastructure such as education and health services.

As part of our fundraising efforts this year, and as a way of finding new ways to raise money for Christian Aid, there will be an afternoon tea with live piano accompaniment. This will take place on Saturday 21st May at 3pm and will cost £7 per person. Please do come along and invite your family and friends. There will be a cake sale as usual and each year lots of you kindly bake for this event. This will take place as part of Messy Church on the morning of 21st May and also at the afternoon tea.
