Do you have a spare room for one or more nights a week? You may be able to help a homeless young person.....

Depaul Nightstop is now seeking volunteers in Sheffield. Established in 1987, Nightstop uses volunteer hosts to give vulnerable young people aged 16-25 a safe place to sleep for the night in a spare room. Last year, 33 Nightstops around the country provided over 13,000 nights of accommodation to young people. Hosts offer young people a meal, a bed for the night and breakfast before they leave. Hosts of all ages offer support as and when is convenient and are fully supported by experienced staff. Drivers are also sought to help young people in getting to and greeting their host for the night. If you think that you could help a young person, then go along for a cup of tea and a chat on *Tuesday 19th July* between 1pm-3pm at Zest, 18 Upperthorpe, S6 3NA, or *Thursday 28th July* 6pm-7pm at Depaul, 176 Eyre Street, S1 4QZ (opposite Decathlon).
