##### ❖ Big Jubilee Lunch

Today we are holding our Big Jubilee Lunch. It will take place in the church car park (weather permitting) at 12:30pm and we have invited our neighbours from the Crookes community to join us. The idea of the Big Jubilee Lunch is to get as many people as possible to sit down and have lunch together on the first Sunday in June. The Big Lunch is all about community, friendship and fun! We have also got some commemorative Diamond Jubilee New Testaments which we will be giving out to those who come along. Please come and join us.

##### ❖ Alpha

Wesley Ebenezer are running an Alpha course at Walkley. It will run mainly on Thursday evenings during June, the next session being this Thursday at 6.30pm. This is an opportunity for us to talk to others, and to ourselves, about what's important to us about the Christian faith. The course is designed so that we eat together, listen together, talk together and pray together as we explore the basics of our beliefs: who was Jesus and why did he die?; why is it important to pray and read the Bible?; how does the Holy Spirit help us to be followers of Jesus? The course is being run for two groups of people: those within the life of the church who want to know more about Jesus or to refresh themselves in the core beliefs and values of Christianity; and those who aren't yet a part of the church – our neighbours, friends or colleagues, whom we could invite to join us. Now is the time to start thinking about who you could invite along and to start praying for them. The good news of Jesus isn't just for the church: "The promise is for you, for your children, and for all who are far off—for all that the Lord our God will call." (Acts 2:39). If there is someone you would like to invite, please pick up a flyer for them from the back of church giving details and dates.
