### ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING...

#### ❖ Annual General Meeting

Our Annual General Meeting will be held on *Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> April*. We will start with a meal at 6:00pm followed by the meeting. There is a list on the notice board at the back of the Worship Area for you to sign up for your meal, cost £2.

#### ❖ Wesley Hall: The Way Forward

For a number of years we have been considering the future of our building. The current layout of our building is not particularly good and the age and size of the building mean that maintenance costs will continue to rise; the fact that the building is listed is an added complication. Additionally we are reliant on

volunteers to maintain and administer the building; an issue made more difficult because of increasing legislation on health and safety, fire regulations etc.

At the Church Meetings held on 19<sup>th</sup> January and 9<sup>th</sup> February we discussed possible options for organising ourselves in order to lessen the burden on the congregation of maintaining the property. The meeting on 9<sup>th</sup> February considered that we should form a Social Enterprise Company to administer the building. On 2<sup>nd</sup> March the Church Council agreed to progress the establishment of a Social Enterprise Company to manage our premises in order that the congregation can be freed to better take forward our Christian mission. Over the last few weeks we have had discussions with: Together for Regeneration, South Yorkshire Funding Advisory Bureau, Voluntary Action Sheffield, one of our local councillors, Freedom2Serve and a firm of architects.

Please come to the Annual Church Meeting on *Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> April* when we can discuss the implications of this in more detail.

#### ❖ **Representatives To The New Wesley Ebenezer Church Council**

At the AGM on *Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> April* we will need to elect representatives to the new combined church council for Wesley Hall & Walkley Ebenezer. We are entitled to elect 5 people, as well as 3 Stewards (who will most likely be Dorothy White, Simone Hardy & Sue Chapman as the members of the Leadership Team who don't have a seat in another capacity). Any church member is eligible to be considered for this, not just those who are currently members of our Church Council.
