Circuit Justice & Peace Action Group Meeting




Circuit Prayer Gathering

Christian Aid

Andrea Killingsworth is no longer able to co-ordinate and lead the fund raising for Christian Aid week and was wondering if anyone would feel able to take on this role. The role has changed to what it was, as effectively the street collection side has ceased; all that happened last year was that Rosemary & Andrea dropped off some envelopes with a flyer about the ceilidh (although this would be optional). Over the years, a considerable amount of money has been raised for Christian Aid, on average £1,200 per year, and last year's ceilidh was a tremendous fund raiser. Due to street collections becoming less popular in many areas, churches are fund raising in different ways. Here at Wesley Hall, we have also had afternoon teas which have been good fundraisers. We also normally do a church collection, which involves getting the envelopes and bank paying-in-slips from Christian Aid, and then banking any funds raised. The role would be what anyone makes of it really, doing as much or little as someone feels able to. It involves being
