

The secondary glazing will be installed this week. The rooms that will benefit from the new glazing are the Church Hall, Committee Room, Emmaus Room and Crèche. The Emmaus Room and Crèche will also be having insulation installed above the suspended ceiling tiles. Once this work is complete, we would like to bring the Crèche room back into use by offering it as a place where parents can leave their young children while they stay in the service. The new Crèche will have toys and figures which can be used to act out simple Bible stories, as well as a better range of age appropriate toys to play with. The Leadership Team has been discussing this but we realise that in order to offer a staffed crèche, we need volunteers to make it happen.
