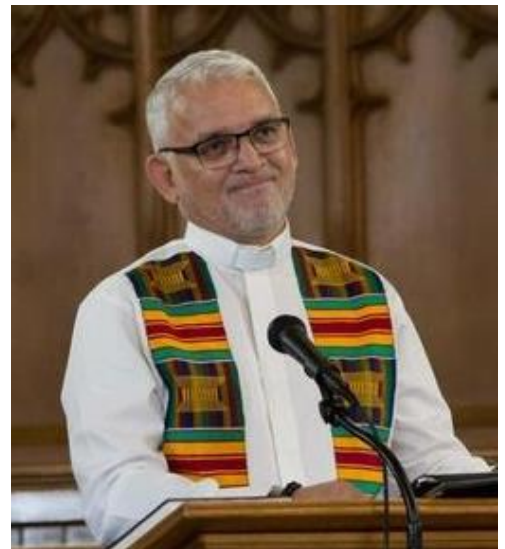
I have a passion for issues of social justice and have worked in the field of HIV/AIDS - training lay counsellors and caregivers of orphans and vulnerable children.
