Born out of Jean Parker's own experience of cancer, "Good Grief" presents a powerful and unique visual exploration of the grief process relating not only to loss of health, but also to significant loss of any kind.

The exhibition aims to stimulate discussion about the powerful emotions experienced after loss, which can feel overwhelming. Visualised as a process of transitional stages, "Good Grief" hopes to provide
