


#### Cliff Festival 2023

Cliff Festival 2023 runs from *Friday 26<sup>th</sup> – Monday 29<sup>th</sup> May* at Cliff College in Derbyshire. Expect morning and evening worship and Bible teaching, seminars, games and activities for people of all ages, opportunities to be reenergised and resourced for mission – and all in the stunning surrounds of the Peak District. The theme this year is Eden Restored and the morning bible studies will be led by Dr Ruth Valerio. Other contributors will be announced shortly and closer to the event the programme will be available on the Cliff College website. They run excellent youth and children's work provision for children aged 2 and upwards.

There is the option to visit for the day as well as buying a ticket for the whole weekend (entry is free to all under 18s). Day passes are £22 for adults or £15 for concessions (65 or over/ students/







living with a disability or on benefits). We won't be having a service here at Wesley Hall on *Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May*, so that would be a great opportunity to come and see what it is like!

#### **❖** Same-Sex Marriage - Living with Contradictory Views in the Church

All who are connected to the congregation of Wesley Hall Methodist Church are welcome to come and share in this open meeting on *Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June*, from 7:00pm – 9:00pm, in the Sanctuary.

The congregation at Wesley Hall has a range of views about whether we should register to allow Same-Sex Marriage in our church. This means that whatever decision the Church takes on this issue, some will disagree with it. At this meeting everyone from the church is invited to come together to consider:

- how we make decisions as Christian people;
- how committed Christian people can come to opposite views;
- how we live with these different views in the church.

The Church Council will meet separately, later in June, to decide whether Wesley Hall will register its building for Same-Sex Marriage or not.
