Depaul Nightstop is now seeking volunteers in Sheffield. Established in 1987, Nightstop uses volunteer hosts to give vulnerable young people aged 16-25 a safe place to sleep for the night in their spare room. Last year 33 Nightstops around the country provided over 13,000 nights of accommodation to young people. Hosts offer young people a meal, bed for the night and breakfast before they leave. Hosts of all ages offer support as and when is convenient and are fully supported by experienced staff. Drivers are also sought to help young people in getting to and greeting their host for the night.
