❖ Lay Worker Management Teams

We have three separate lay worker management teams, one for each of our lay workers, and are currently looking for new members! The three teams each support a different person and focus on a different area of church life:

Matt Irons, Building Manager: looking at the building (upkeep, maintenance and improvements), finances (monitoring income, expenditure and budget setting) and room hire (dealing with requests, issues and matters relating to our tenants).

Jacque Ryan, Families & Community Co-Ordinator: looking after and continually reviewing our children and families programme including Toddler Group, Messy Church, Holiday Clubs (including link with St. Tim's) and 3Generate, and to act a sounding board for futures ideas and plans.

Now recruiting: Pre-teen & Youth Worker: looking after and continually reviewing our youth programme including Yeast, Drop Inn and Retrogaming, and looking at new ways to create an new event/ group (or something else) to plug the gap between the after school Drop Inn and Retro-gaming (both with no Christian content) and our Sunday evening church group Yeast (mostly Christian content). This group is currently recruiting for a new person to take on the role.
